The CDC estimates that over 48 million Americans become sick from food-borne illnesses each year, at an annual cost to the US of more than \$15.6 billion. The food handler is the key link in the prevention of these foodborne-illness outbreaks. Patrick County Extension offers the ServSafe Food Protection Manager class and exam every other month each calendar year. Over the past 10 years, more than 250 food industry personnel from Patrick and its surrounding counties successfully became certified food protection managers, through 4000 hours of instruction. The next scheduled class and exam is January 27th and 31st, 2025.
